

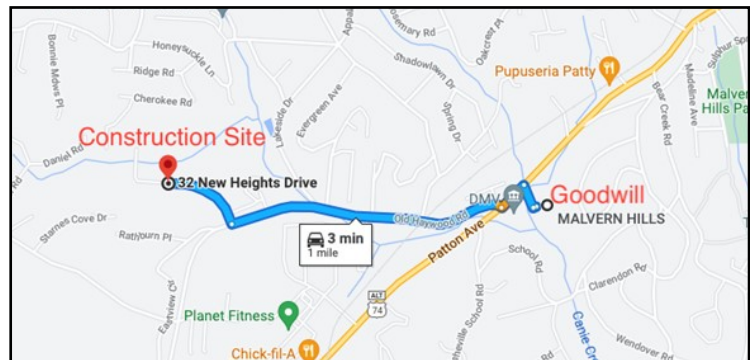


New Heights: Volunteer Information



Thank you for volunteering to build homes and change lives on the Asheville Area Habitat Jobsite! During this build volunteers will: frame floors and walls, set trusses, raise roof ladders, install doors and windows, paint, stucco and landscape. No experience is necessary, just come prepared to work hard and have fun!

We build year-round, Monday– Saturday. Here's a typical day on the jobsite:	
8am -8:15	Carpool from Goodwill
8:15	Arrive on-site, sign-in
8:30	Orientation & Safety Talk <i>*Attendance is required</i>
10:00-10:15	Morning Break
11:30-12:00	Lunch <i>*Friday shift ends at noon</i>
1:30-1:45	Afternoon Break
3:00-3:15	Tool clean-up, depart

Carpooling is REQUIRED. Please park at the Goodwill (1616 Patton Avenue) and ride to the jobsite together.

Upon Arrival: Please sign-in and bring your completed [Waiver of Liability](#). Volunteers 16-17 years old must bring a [Minor Waiver of Liability](#) that has been signed by a parent or guardian. Work starts promptly 8:30. Please plan to stay the full day. Partial shifts are not allowed except for Fridays when work ends at noon.

Safety: Safety is our top priority. Volunteers are required to attend the daily safety meeting at 8:30. Late arrivals may not be permitted to work. Volunteers are required to use all safety equipment provided and report any injuries to the jobsite supervisor.

COVID-19 Safety: Please cancel your shift if you are sick. Face coverings are optional at this time.

What to bring: Please bring a bag lunch and snacks. Water is provided, but please bring your own drinking containers to help us reduce waste! All tools and safety equipment are provided.

What to wear: Work and weather appropriate clothing and closed toe shoes. Be aware that you might be painting and will probably get dirty! A hat, sunscreen, and gloves are suggested. Safety glasses will be provided and must be worn at all times while on the jobsite.

Bad weather: Work typically continues despite rain or snow. In case of severe conditions, you may call [828-210-9367](tel:828-210-9367) after 7:30 am, for a recorded message to see if the jobsite will be closed.
